TAX APPOINTMENTS ARE FULL

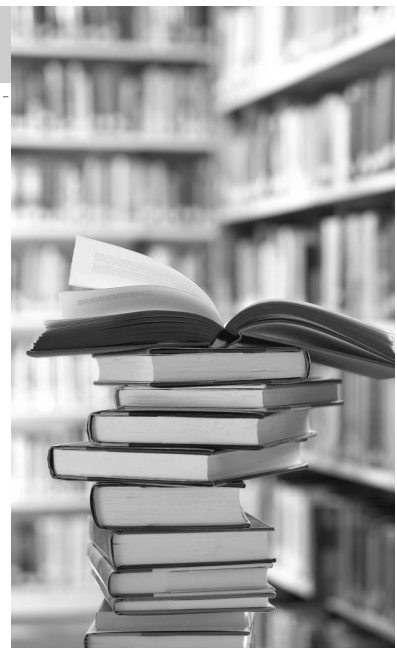
All income tax preparation appointments are now filled. Call CCM Edgewood at 412-731-0909 to be placed on our waiting list.
