CCM will have federal tax forms available by the end of February. We will ONLY have Form 1040 (including Schedules 1-6) and its instruction booklet. All other forms may be downloaded from www.irs.gov/forms-instructions.

CCM will not have Pennsylvania tax forms for 2018 or in the future. The state has discontinued supplying bulk forms to organizations. Visit revenue.pa.gov to file online or download PDF forms.

Tax forms may be printed at CCM free of charge.

If you would like to donate books to the sale, please drop them off before March 1. Donations may be made at CCM Edgewood only. Before donating, please read CCM's donations guide on our website – there are some items we cannot accept.

CCM will begin accepting donations for next year's book sale in April.

Printing, Faxing and Scanning at CCM

Coming Soon: Chromebooks and More WiFi Hotspots!

Starting this spring, CCM will offer Chromebooks and wifi hotspots for checkout.

Chromebooks — lightweight laptops — will be available for checkout from both CCM Edgewood and CCM Forest Hills. Each Chromebook will circulate in a kit that includes a WiFi hotspot.

CCM will now have a total of 15 new WiFi hotspots for checkout; 10 at CCM Edgewood and 5 at CCM Forest Hills. CCM Edgewood previously had a collection of 5 WiFi hotspots at CCM Edgewood, which will now be replaced with new hotspots.

Service animals are permitted to accompany their handler in the library. Emotional support, therapy, comfort, or companion animals are not considered service animals under the ADA.

Resource Spotlight: Flipster & Overdrive Magazines

There are two great ways to read the latest magazines digitally with your library card. Access hundreds of titles on your computer or mobile device using Flipster or Overdrive! Visit CCM's website or ACLA's e-resources page (<http://eresources.einetwork.net/emagazines/>) to find out more about digital magazines.

Flipster

Flipster is a next-generation magazine service that allows people to browse digital versions of popular magazines. Magazines can be downloaded to Android phones and tablets, Apple phones and tablets, and Kindle Fire tablets for offline reading anytime, anywhere.

Flipster offers an easy reading experience. Users can browse magazines by category as well as search for specific periodicals. An online newsstand provides a carousel of the most recent issues, as well as a carousel of all issues allowing for quick access to magazines.

The table of contents contains links for quick access to articles of interest and hotlinks within magazines are hyperlinked, opening in separate tabs when clicked. In addition, there is an option to zoom in and out for better readability.

Overdrive Magazines

Take a look at our new eMagazine collection on OverDrive! Checkouts are simple – just like checking out an eBook or eAudioBook, and magazines are always available so there is never a wait to read the latest issue!

Since our subscription just started, we only have the most recent issues available. As new issues are released, they will be added to our collection.

Patrons can check out as many eMagazines as they would like, and eMagazine checkouts do not count towards a patron's checkout limit of 20 titles at a time. After downloading an eMagazine, patrons can keep them until the due date just like other OverDrive content. As with eBooks and eAudiobooks, eMagazines remain checked out to a patron until the patron either manually returns it or the loan period expires. While eMagazines are not renewable, there are no holds so eMagazines are always available.

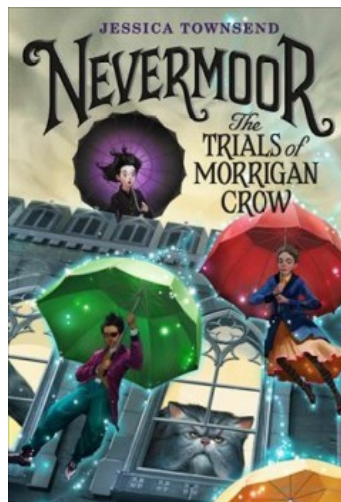
Staff Recommendations
