Starting this spring, CCM will offer Chromebooks and wifi hotspots for checkout.

Patricia M. DeMarco is a native of Pittsburgh, PA, with a doctorate in Biology from the University of Pittsburgh. She has spent a thirty-year career in energy and environmental policy in both private and public sector positions. She was the Executive Director of the Rachel Carson Homestead Association and Director of the Rachel Carson Institute at Chatham University. Her book, titled "Pathways to Our Sustainable Future – A Global Perspective from Pittsburgh" explores positive pathways toward sustainability, based on 28 case studies in Pittsburgh. She is the Executive Producer of a documentary film with Mark E. Dixon, "The Power of One Voice – A 50 Year Perspective on the Life of Rachel Carson" and has served as technical advisor for a video series with Kirsi Jansa

titled "Sustainability Pioneers." On November 3, 2015, Patricia DeMarco was elected to the Forest Hills Borough Council.
