Chromebooks and Wi-Fi Hotspots!

Chromebooks (lightweight laptops) are now available for checkout from both CCM Edgewood and CCM Forest Hills. Each Chromebook will circulate in a kit that includes a Wi-Fi hotspot. CCM has a total of 15 new hotspots for checkout; 10 at CCM Edgewood and 5 at CCM Forest Hills.

All Chromebooks and hotspots are first-come, first-served; they will check out for 7 days and cannot be placed on hold or renewed. Chromebooks and hotspots are also available at Carnegie Library of Pittsburgh branches.

Visit Local Museums for FREE!

CCM has partnered with the Senator John Heinz History Center Affiliates Program to offer library card-holders access to free admission to five unique sites: **Senator John Heinz History Center** in the Strip District (and its associated museums — Sports Museum, Fort Pitt and Meadowcroft), **Old Economy Village** in Ambridge, **Quecreek Mine Rescue Site** in Somerset, **Historic Harmony Museum** in Harmony and the **David Bradford House** in Washington, Pa.



This program offers families free admission for up to four people, as well as additional information and suggestions on other things to do in the area. It's basically a road trip in a bag!

All experience kits are first-come, first-served; they will check out for 7 days and cannot be placed on hold or renewed. Experience kits will be available at both CCM Edgewood and CCM Forest Hills. If the kit you are looking for isn't available at a CCM location, there are 19 other local libraries that offer experience kits (including the Swissvale and Wilkinsburg libraries).

Resource Spotlight: Libby

Ebooks and audiobooks are great for traveling. They are portable and accessible across lots of different media. Using a smartphone, tablet, e-reader or laptop, patrons can take their library with them wherever they go.

The free Libby app is the easiest way to get started. Libby has the same resources as Overdrive — but Libby is an app that is more user-friendly. Libby offers adult, teen, and children's fiction, nonfiction, popular authors in eBooks, audio-books, and even magazines.

There are SO MANY reasons why we love Libby:

- Download books and audiobooks for offline reading, or stream them to save space.
- Libby can send ebooks directly to your Kindle or other e-reader.
- All your loans and holds are consolidated on a single shelf.
- Keep track of your reading history in the Activity tab.
- Positions, bookmarks, and notes are kept in sync across your devices.
- Sample any book with a tap — nothing to download or delete.
- Try a zoomable graphic novel, or a picture book with readalong audio.

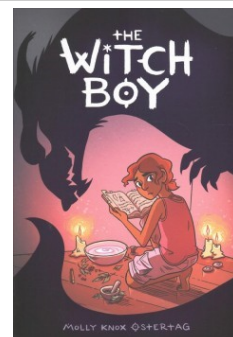

In thirteen-year-old Aster's family, all the girls are raised to be witches, while boys grow up to be shapeshifters. Anyone who dares cross those lines is exiled. Unfortunately for Aster, he still hasn't shifted . . . and he's still fascinated by witchery, no matter how forbidden it might be. When a mysterious danger threatens the other boys, Aster knows he can help — as a witch.

With charming artwork, interesting supporting characters, natural-feeling diversity, and peeks of a richly developed world, this book leaves readers wishing for more. Recommended for ages 8 and up.
