**PA Forward | Pennsylvania Libraries** is a new initiative of the Pennsylvania Library Association. It was created to give voice to what the library community already knows, and what other states throughout the nation are also recognizing: With the right support, libraries are ideally positioned to become the community centers of information, technology, and learning that will fuel educational and economic opportunity for all citizens.

Libraries are no longer just buildings that house books. Today's libraries are agile institutions serving real-life needs. They hold the key to powering progress and elevating the quality of life in Pennsylvania by fueling the types of knowledge essential to success: Basic Literacy, Information Literacy, Civic and Social Literacy, Health Literacy, and Financial Literacy.



## Basic Literacy

Libraries can push Pennsylvania to achieve one of the highest literacy rates in the country, a better trained and more skilled workforce, and a growing tax base, economy, and population.

CCM offers a robust slate of early literacy programs for children of all ages. Sing and rhyme at Baby Lapsit, sit for a story at Family Storytime, or practice phonics at Kindergarten Readiness.

## Information Literacy

Libraries can help all Pennsylvanians learn how to use online resources and current technology to improve their education, to enhance their job skills, and to participate fully in a digital society.

CCM's new Chromebook and hotspot lending program has helped library patrons get online wherever they are.

## Civic & Social Literacy

Libraries can give citizens of all ages the knowledge and skills they need to improve their lives, to contribute effectively in their communities, and to participate in civil discourse.

The Friends of the Library sponsors a biweekly conversation salon at CCM Forest Hills, where community members can gather for friendly conversation on a variety of topics.

## Health Literacy

Libraries can play an important role in helping citizens actively manage their own and their family's well-being, making them effective partners with their healthcare providers and reducing costs.

CCM hosts a morning walking groups and provides regular health and wellness programming. Check out a book on hiking trails or an audiobook on meditation today!

## Financial Literacy

Digital resources aren't just for adults! Allegheny County's eLibrary has a special section just for kids. Visit [elibrary.einetwork.net/kids](http://elibrary.einetwork.net/kids) to access ebooks, interactive learning, and more. All of these resources are FREE with your library card!

**BBC Earth** has short stories and videos about animals and habitats, plus discoveries and challenges on planet Earth.

**Bookflix** pairs video storybooks with ebooks to build a love of reading and learning.

**Common Sense Media** is a site which offers independent ratings and reviews for movie, TV shows, books, and other media so that parents can make informed decisions about the entertainment their kids are consuming.

**CyberSmarts** has ebooks to teach kids and teens how to safely use the internet and social media.

**Kids InfoBits** is where elementary aged children can explore educational topics, from animals to geography to health, and find articles, pictures, charts, graphs, and more.

**Little Pim** is an interactive language program for kids, including: Arabic, Chinese, English, French, German, Hebrew, Italian, Japanese, Russian, and Spanish.

**NoveList K-8 Plus** has information about books for grades K-8 that includes suggested reads, review, articles, and reading recommendations for both fiction and non-fiction.

**OverDrive for Kids** lets you browse or search ONLY the children's titles available from OverDrive. Like the main site, which still includes all of the children's materials, the OverDrive for Kids page includes ebooks, e-audio and some e-videos too. Search "Read-Along" for audio with the book.

**TruFlix** has kids' ebooks that are enhanced with related content including primary sources, videos, audio clips, images, and related websites.
